LENTEN REGULATIONS:

- 1. Each member of the Catholic Church is asked to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. No one is dispensed from the obligation of penance proclaimed by Christ. "Unless you do penance you shall all likewise perish."***
- 2. Those Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from the use of meat on Ash Wednesday, on each Friday of Lent and on Good Friday.***
- 3. Those Catholics who have celebrated their 21st birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should eat only one meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of your 59th birthday.***
- 4. All priests and confessors are authorized to dispense individuals and families from specific acts of penance prescribed by the Church, but not from the general obligation of penance during Lent.***
- 5. Our people should be helped and encouraged to adopt a Lenten program that includes prayer, works of charity and concern for the poor, the aged and sick; donations to the needy; spiritual reading and similar acts of Christian faith.***
